The meeting was held on Wednesday May 21, 2013 at the Rowe Fire Station, 4 Sibley Road in Rowe. The meeting was called to order by Moderator Robert Clancy at 6:30 p.m. with One Hundred Seventy Seven (177) Voters in attendance and eight (8) audience members at the start of the meeting. Moderator Clancy swore in the meeting tellers and welcome new selectmen Susan Gleason. Moderator Clancy thanked Mr. Paul McLatchy III for his service to the town as selectmen and Mr. McLatchy received a round of applause. Moderator Clancy informed the voters that Article 1 would be voted by secret ballot at the request of several voters prior to the start of the STM.

**ARTICLE 1:** A motion was made and seconded to see if the town will vote to **RAISE AND APPROPRIATE** the sum of six million three hundred seven thousand two hundred dollars (**\$6,307,200.00**), for the purpose of constructing, equipping and furnishing a new elementary school, including the payment of all costs incidental or related thereto  
*Recommended by the School Building Committee*

*Susan Zvatoka chair of the School Building Committee presented a short PowerPoint presentation along with the Design Architect and Owners Project Manager.*

**Article 1: Passed 104 – Yes 72- No**

**ARTICLE 2:** A motion was made and seconded to see if the Town will vote to **APPROPRIATE from AVAILABLE FUNDS any sum for** the maintenance, repair, improvement and construction of town highways, or any other purpose allowed under Chapter 90, which amounts shall be reimbursed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts through funds made available by Chapter 90.

**Article 2: Passed Unanimously by Show of Hands**

**ARTICLE 3:** To transact any other business that may lawfully come before the meeting.
