Review Revised School Budget –

The Finance Committee and Board of Selectmen examined the updated FY26 School Budget. The school managed to implement further cuts, reducing the budget to meet the 2.5% threshold. It should be noted that the school was able to absorb the increased health insurance cost.

The Finance Committee voted to approve the budget as submitted. Vote: 3-0-0

Although the Board of Selectmen will be voting on each individual article at a later meeting, Chair Silva and Selectmen Baker voted to approve the School budget as submitted.

Matt Stine, a member of the School Committee, inquired whether the school and all town departments would need to cover the annual increases in health insurance costs. Chair Pallotta confirmed that they would, but only for the increase itself.
