We talked about moving plants around to different gardens where they are needed now, and placing mums and other plants at Brittingham Hill Garden. We decided not to start any new garden beds until more people are able to help plant, water, weed, mulch and maintain them. Bigger planters are needed for the wall by the dam. Sign at Heath/Rowe town line needs 10" pots (they are now 8".) More white sticks are needed for holiday decorations, and should be put in the ground before the first frost. Next year, use hanging hooks in Brittingham Hill Garden. Dwayne and Jeanne Hicks gave very good prices for materials. Cyndie will thank them. Next year, smaller gardens can be included in Garden Tour.
