

Board of Health  
Meeting Minutes  
March 15, 1988

The meeting was called to order at 7:39 P.M.

Mrs. Foberg reported that she had received a request that the town investigate some kind of arrangement to alleviate the septage haulers' problems of where to dispose of pumped sewage. Mrs. Foberg had discussed the matter with John Brickett (Health Agent/Sanitarian). The possibility of a municipal leach field will be investigated further.

The Chairman had also received a call from Lillian Danek (Cross Road) who requested permission to make certain types of candy in her home for sale in a store in Shelburne Falls. There was a motion to give approval for making (for sale to the public) peanut brittle and chocolate candy (with pre-made chocolate) to Lillian Danek in her home. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously. It was noted that if Mrs. Danek at a later time wished to make any other types of foodstuffs for sale she would need to seek approval from the Board of Health.

It was noted that Mr. Brickett had turned over the licensing of septic system installers and sewage haulers to the Board. There was a motion to raise the fee for these permits to \$25.00 beginning January 1, 1989. The motion was seconded and approved unanimously.

Mrs. Foberg reported that Fred Filios (Sanitarian) will perform a percolation test on the Davis Mine Road property of Molly Scott on April 7th. Mr. Brickett was contacted regarding the arrangements.


The meeting was adjourned at 7:54 P.M.
