Meeting Minutes
June 27, 1989

The meeting was called to order at 8:25 P.M.

Mrs. Foberg and John Brickett, R.S. (Health Agent/Sanitarian) inspected the Rowe Camp. Mr. Brickett recommended that a new dishwasher be a priority for next year. He felt that the present one is undersized. The water for the dishwasher was not up to temperature (180 degrees), and he recommended that this situation be corrected.

A bill was received from Berkshire Enviro-Labs for March.

Mrs. Foberg and Mr. Riggan conducted an inspection at the Vaughn Tower property on Leshure Road on Wednesday, June 22 to determine if the gray water was properly connected to the septic system. The hook-up was approved, and a letter was sent to Mr. Tower confirming this. (see attached)

A brochure was received from Waterworks Laboratories of Leominster, Massachusetts outlining their water testing services. It will be kept on file for future reference.


