January 8, 1991

The meeting was called to order at 10:10 P.M.

Also present was Margaret Rice, Chairman of the Rowe School Committee. Mrs. Rice reported that equipment formerly shared between the Town and the School, (audio and visual screening equipment and a glucometer), was now under the jurisdiction of the Town Nurse, and was therefore not available to the School Nurse. She asked if the equipment could be returned to the school until money could be appropriated or transferred for the purchase of new equipment for use in the school. The existing equipment had been purchased by the Board of Health during the time the Town and School Nurse position was filled by one person, and therefore belongs to the Town. The Board suggested that the use of the equipment be shared between the town and the school and that this arrangement should be worked out between the two nurses involved. Mrs. Rice was asked to add a line item for the new equipment to the school budget for FY 1992.




The meeting adjourned at 10:20 P.M.
