January 11, 1994

The meeting was called to order at 9:15 P.M.

In receipt of a check for \$25.00 it was voted to grant a septage pumpers/haulers license to Houghton Sanitary Service of Guilford, Vermont, effective this date.

A report was received from School Nurse Ellie Silva that she administered a total of 29 flu vaccines to Rowe residents in October, November and December. The excess vaccine is to be returned to the Department of Public Health in Amherst.

A list of well drillers approved by the Department of Environmental Management was received for file.


Chairman Foberg reported that Mary Jo Phelps contacted her regarding a proposed modification to her house on Leshure Road relative to the adequacy of the present septic system. This modification entails construction of a peaked roof to allow for proper shedding of snow and rain. It was the consensus of the Board to approve the modification because it would not increase the living space of the house. However, any future alterations would demand reassessment by the Board at that time. Chairman Foberg will contact Mrs. Phelps to inform her of the decision.


The Chairman called Bill Allen (County Engineer) regarding the status of the permit application for the transfer station. Mr. Allen said that he has been very busy and promised to call Chairman Foberg as soon as possible.


The meeting adjourned at 9:45 P.M.
