MINUTES OF MEETING
CONSERVATION COMMISSION
JULY 6, 2009

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: 2:00 p.m.

1 Jack Williams, representing the Historic Commission, requested that the Conservation Commission sign a letter of support (see attached letter) for the creation of an Historic District for the Town of Rowe. Bob Clancy moved that this be done; Bob Rice seconded the motion. The motion passed with two yes votes and Myra Carlow abstained.

2. The Commission unanimously approved the Minutes of May 5, 2009, with the amendment to list Nancy Brown as an absent member.


3. The Commission addressed a Request for Applicability for the work to be done to repair the septic system of Lisa Bryant (see attached). Although the septic system is near the stream, the repair must be made and steps will be taken to mitigate damage to the stream. Bob Clancy moved that the finding be "Not Applicable by virtue of Reason # 5 as described in Section C.b. of the Project Description". Myra Carlow seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

4. The Commission addressed a Request for Applicability for property owned by Daniel Golden on Leshure Rd. (see attached). All work to be done will be outside the 200 ft. river front area. The motion was made and passed unanimously to make a "Negative Determination, by virtue of reason # 4."

The meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
