Minutes

TRANSFER STATION

Attendants Logs

Repairs

Kitty Litter

Narcan

The board discussed an email from the nurse suggesting the BOH encourage Rowe EMS to purchase nasal Narcan so it is available to EMS personnel in event of an overdose. The board felt it best that the suggestion come from the Selectmen. Marcella will contact the Selectmen.

TITLE V

Grodd

The board instructed Marcella to draft a letter to Alexander Grodd reminding him that a mandated Title V inspection is needed on his property located at 38 Pond Rd. Mr. Grodd purchased the property almost two years ago.

Permits

Installer permit application for James Williams was approved, permit signed and issued.
Application for a Disposal System Construction permit for Volland/Audette (127 County Rd) was approved, permit was signed and issued.

School Septic System

School committee member Susan Zavotka requested an extension of the scheduled Title V inspection: Jennifer stated that all involved parties are committed for the planned date. Dave feels that the board should abide by the schedule agreed upon by BOH and School Committee which was for this spring.
After some discussion the board agreed to proceed with the inspection as scheduled (May 14 at 1:00pm).
