Call to Order 6:00 PM by Maggie Rice

- Andrea sent the SPHS Local Septic Regs/Private Well Regs to be reviewed by the Board and consider adoption so we will be in line with the State regulations. All members of the Board will review them to be discussed at the meeting on October 17th when Andrea Crete is here.
- The final template for the BOH Marijuana Regs will also be reviewed by the Board for the meeting on October 17th as well.

Water Testing

- Beach Testing for the last 3 weeks in August was reviewed, everything was good.
- Water testing for Rowe School was reviewed – all good.

New Business

- Yankee has submitted their Biennial Inspection Report it will be filed.
- There is a Title 5 seminar in Holyoke – Maggie took the info and may be going
