

**Town of Rowe FY2018
Board of Health
Meeting Minutes for September 19, 2018**

Call to Order 6:05 PM by Maggie Rice

The minutes from the meeting of September 6, 2018, minutes could not be accepted due to the absence of David Cousineau .

The bills were reviewed and signed.

Transfer Station

-The log was reviewed.

- A camera needs to be purchased for the Transfer Station ahead of the institution of fees for the yearly stickers. Joanne will research them and find the best method of purchase. She will also research signage that will be posted at the transfer station about dumping outside of gates.

- Fees for dump stickers was discussed and a motion was made that for 2019 a sticker will cost \$25 a piece and will have to have proof of residency in order to purchase, motion carried. A motion was made that we use numbered hang tags so residents wouldn't be limited to one vehicle or purchase two tickets, motion carried. The hang tags will be numbered and recorded with resident at time of purchase. Penalties for abuse of tags was decided to be 1st Offense – Warning, 2nd Offense- \$50 Fine, 3rd Offense -\$100 Fine, 4th Offense – Loss of Use of Transfer Station

- A motion was made to approve up to an additional \$250.00 for the hazardous waste disposal event run by FCSWMD. Motion carried.

Health Services

-The log was reviewed.

- No one from the BOH other than the town nurse will be attending the EDS Drill Planning Meeting.

Permits/Pumping/FRCOG

-There is a Title 5 inspection at 30 Old Cyrus Stage Rd on September 28th. Maggie will attend.

- Joanne will talk to Town Officials about the use of the Gracy House to groups of any kind due to the fragility of the septic system.

- On October 17th the Board will be discussing new regulations to be put into effect concerning wells and septic systems with Andrea. These are necessary to bring us up to regulations used within the state.

Water Testing

- The water tests for the Town Hall, Avery Fountain and Pelham Lake Park were reviewed, all fine.

New Business

- There will be a budget meeting on Monday, November 5 at 6:30 PM at Rowe School. Maggie will attend.

Old Business

Maggie has driven by the home of Dohn Sherman and reported that it looks like very little has been done to mitigate the junk problem. It has been over 30 days since he was told to clean up the junk, cars and hazardous waste. Joanne will talk to Kevin Sprague and Jim Lively to see if he has been bringing stuff to the transfer station. A letter will be mailed saying the 30 days is up and requesting he attend our meeting on October 17th for a follow up. When to inform the Planning Board about the unregistered vehicles and the Conservation Committee about potential hazardous waste was discussed. Joanne will contact Andrea Crete about further steps to be taken.
