3. New Business:

Fitness Center: Deb Lively (Fitness Center Attendant) is having an Open House next Wednesday, 3/14/17 from 9-11 AM to promote the new fitness center hours.

Park Commissioners would like a written set of procedures for school choice use of the Park facilities. The school will be contacted for possible written procedures from the School Committee regarding this topic.

Put notice in Goal Post for April, job applications for summer positions will be due by May 1, 2017.

Contact Josh Smith for estimate to repair and refinish fitness center floor in the town hall.

Price out cost of split rail fence to replace the one at Percy Brown picnic area.

Look into possible grants from the US Tennis Association to help with repairs or replacement of existing tennis courts in the future.

4. Old Business:

Results of the Survey and Management Recommendations by Lycott Environmental (on town website) was discussed. Overall the health of the lake seems okay with possible solutions for remediation expensive and not ideal. The survey will serve as a baseline for the health of the lake for future reference. No action will be taken at this time.

Beth Flaherty will be at the next Park Commission meeting to discuss possible plans for the summer 2017 Recreation Program.

Possible new equipment purchase of either a rower or spin bike is still under discussion.

Double stone fireplace replacement estimates: Vermont Stonework \$3000. Discussed cheaper, more affordable alternatives. Discussion will continue with further research to be done.

Money left in the budget to replace broken tiles on the outside floor of the bathrooms before summer season. Discussion of possible replacement materials for this 64 square foot area underneath cover. Discussed nonslip tiles versus Trek flooring.

Railings for the bathroom walkway are complete and should be installed this spring.

Tennis courts will be patched and cleaned for summer use.
